The Center for Recovery Services offers individual treatment for adults, adolescents and families who are struggling with substance use, abuse, and addiction.

We are open Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM to provide treatment for substance use and related issues. Evening appointments are also available.

Our services are provided by Licensed Independent Clinical Social Workers, Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors and dedicated Case Managers. If medication management is needed, we have an on-site Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner who will evaluate and educate you on medication options.

Our clinical staff provides substance abuse counseling through individual and group outpatient therapy to support clients moving toward a richer and fuller life of sobriety.

## Vivitrol Treatment

We offer Vivitrol as part of a comprehensive, medically supervised addiction treatment program at CRS. The nurse practitioner will make the clinical decision if it is the appropriate treatment for you. This monthly shot can help you reach your goal of maintaining a healthy, sober life. Vivitrol, the brand name of naltrexone, is a prescription medicine used to:

### **Treat alcohol dependence**

### **Prevent relapse to opioid dependence after opioid detox**

You must stop drinking and taking opioids or other opioid-containing medications before starting Vivitrol.

The following steps are necessary before Vivitrol treatment can begin:

- Schedule an intake appointment with one of our clinicians.
- Schedule an appointment with our Nurse Practitioner.
- Lab tests, including liver function and blood cell counts, must be done before and within 90 days of start of treatment.
- Please provide a valid insurance card or have the ability to self-pay.
- You MUST be 7-10 days opioid-free to begin treatment.
