We are open Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM to provide treatment for substance use and related issues. Individual and group sessions are offered. Day and evening appointments are available.

We Accept MassHealth, MBHP, NHP, BMC GIC, Fallon, Tufts Network Health, Celticare, Blue Cross Blue Shield, Harvard Pilgrim, UBH and Tufts Health Plan, as well as self-pay.

If you do not have the ability to pay please call us for available options. We may be able to offer free care.



The Center for Recovery Services offers individual and group treatment for adults, adolescents and families who are struggling with substance use, abuse, and addiction.

Our services are provided by Licensed Independent Clinical Social Workers, Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors and dedicated Case Managers who will offer alternative strength-based ways of handling problems and situations.

Our clinical staff provides substance abuse counseling, outpatient therapy and anger management groups to support clients with any issues that may be preventing them from moving toward a richer and fuller life.

If medication management is needed, we have an on-site Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner who will evaluate and educate the client on medication options, including Vivitrol.

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The Center for Recovery Services is easily accessed via the MBTA Red Line and is only a 5 minute walk from Andrew Station.
