DEVINE RECOVERY CENTER

Our center is a welcoming and safe environment for those in recovery to meet new peers in a social environment. Come attend a recovery meeting, play a game of pool, ping pong or horseshoes, work on a job search in our computer room, or work out in our fitness room.

Member activities include movie nights, card games, coffee hour, day trips, monthly members group meeting, recovery meetings, advocacy in addiction recovery, and volunteer opportunities in the center and in the community. DRC sponsored events include our annual Women in Recovery night, summer SoberFest and a number of Recovery Month celebrations.

The DRC hosts MOAR (Massachusetts Organization for Addiction Recovery) meetings at the center on the second Wednesday of the month. MOAR's mission is to organize recovering individuals, families and friends into a collective voice to educate the public about the value of recovery from alcohol and other addictions.

Members also collaborate with other peer recovery centers in Massachusetts for a variety of activities including softball and basketball tournaments. All come together for the game, meet other peers in recovery, eat great food, and have some good sober fun!

We host a free Narcan training the third Thursday of the month through the Boston Public Health Commission. Learn how to administer Narcan and take home a free kit. You could potentially save a life.
